Eligibility

Applicant must be pursuing a graduate or undergraduate degree in Recreation, Leisure Studies, Human Services, Public Administration, or a closely related field and must meet two of the three requirements:

1. Minimum GPA of 3.0.
2. Applicant must maintain a full-time student status of 12 semester units or more (or quarter equivalent) or a part-time status of 6 semester units or more (or quarter equivalent) and are working 20-40 hours a week (to be verified). Graduate students must maintain 9 semester units for full-time student status or 3 semester units and be working 20-40 hours per week for part-time status.
3. Minimum of one (1) year experience in a paid or volunteer municipal setting.

Requirements

Application must be accompanied with the following:

1. Most recent transcripts and/or grade report.
2. A professional resume.
3. Two (2) letters of recommendation from persons not related to you.
*Letters of recommendation must be typed, signed, include contact information, and submitted on letterhead.
4. Submission of Supplemental Questions.
5. Applicants working full-time must include a copy of employer's tuition reimbursement policy and/or a written statement, if a reimbursement policy does not exist.

Supplemental Questions

Please use additional paper to respond to these questions:

1. What do you feel is the role of Women in Leisure Services (WILS)?
2. Why is Recreation your choice of career and what are your professional goals after you attain your degree?
3. How will this scholarship benefit you in attaining your professional goals?
4. Please describe your involvement with any clubs and professional organizations to which you belong. Describe how this involvement has and/or will help you enhance your professional skills within the recreation profession.
5. Scholarship recipients are encouraged to participate on a WILS professional programs or special events committee. If selected as a recipient, what committee would you be willing to serve on? *Please see attachment for list of committees.*
